COVID-19 VACCINATION INFORMATION and BOOKING AVAILABILITY

King Street Medical Centre has been named as a major COVID-19 vaccination provider through the Murwillumbah Respiratory Clinic (located at 14 King Street Medical Centre, Murwillumbah NNSW); and also our Cabarita Beach Medical Centre (located at 22 Tweed Coast Road, Cabarita Beach NNSW) have been selected as major providers of COVID-19 vaccination.

This means vaccinations will be available for all eligible patients who attend either of these two practices. We will also be able to vaccinate patients from other practices if their practice is not providing this service.

The government has advised we will receive an initial supply of Astra Zeneca vaccines by the end of March.

If I am not Phase 1B, when will I be able to get vaccinated?

If you are not eligible under the 1(b) category please don't phone for an appointment. We will advise via our website when vaccines are available for the next category.

It will take some time to get through all those who are eligible in the 1(b) category as we only receive a certain number of vaccines each week. Please be understanding

of the fact we will have limited supplies and we therefore need everyone to be patient while more supplies and bookings become available.

Vaccination booking dates will commence from Saturday 10 April at Murwillumbah Respiratory Clinic and from Thursday 8 April at Cabarita Beach Medical Centre.

Our receptionists are extremely busy answering non-COVID patient enquiries so please don't call about vaccines until the website advises they are available and then we strongly encourage you to book online wherever possible to make it quicker for you and to prevent a phone overload and long waits for you.

How many Doses Will I Need?

To complete vaccination for COVID-19 you will require 2 vaccines separated by 12 weeks. There must also be a 2 week gap between other vaccines such as Influenza vaccines and the COVID-19 vaccine.

It is important to note that two vaccine doses are required at the same vaccination centre. Both appointments are to be booked when you book your Dose 1.

What Vaccine Will I get?

All Community immunisation will be with the Astra-Zeneca vaccine. Some will be sourced from overseas and some will be manufactured in Australia.

Is It Free?

The Covid-19 vaccine will be free for all Australian Citizens, Permanent Residents + visa holders.
